Whereas the Olympia Unitarian Universalist Congregation (OUUC) functions on a fiscal year (FY) budget basis with the FY ending on December 31st with funding sourced from congregant pledges and miscellaneous other sources *and*

Whereas the Bylaws require that the OUUC annual budget be approved by the Congregation prior to the beginning of the FY *and*

Whereas this year inclement weather prevented the Congregation from meeting on Friday December 14, 2018 the date duly selected to approve the 2019 FY budget *and*

Whereas the congregation cannot function without access to operating funds *and*

Whereas the Bylaws provide for the Board of Directors (Board) to adopt a Continuing Resolution authorizing continued operations for up to 30 calendar days when necessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board does hereby adopt this Continuing Resolution authorizing continued operation of the OUUC at 2018 FY funding levels for up to 30 calendar days from the date of this Resolution or until the Congregation can approve the 2019 budget whichever occurs sooner.

Amendment to Minutes for April 2017 OUUC Board Meeting

Amended Board Minutes of April 11, 2017.

1) Amended Minutes of April 11, 2017. The settlement agreement for Reverend Perchlik was approved on April 11, 2017 executive session. This agreement included a payroll settlement amount of \$56,000. The settlement payment was in the form of 2 lump sum salary payments on his already approved contract. Since the congregation had already approved the salary in the operations budget the board concluded that no additional authorization was necessary to make the settlement payments.

2) Approval of payments. In keeping with the practice followed normally when payments are approved we have two signatures on this document. The payment of the Thomas Perchlik settle agreement of \$56,000 is hereby authorized retroactively. The payments were made as noted in #1 above. The payment was previously approved by the board in an executive session of April 11, 2017.
