Spiritual Practice

Soul Matters Sharing Circles are open events, not requiring preregistration or a long-term commitment, and meet on the 2nd Sunday of each month, 12:45 - 2:00 pm. Come meet new people and explore a theme with deep and thoughtful questions. This follows our 2nd Sunday Lunch, so eat first then join the circle.

Covenant Circles are closed groups of people who make a commitment to continue meeting together for the church year (usually October to May). In this model, you meet with the same people each month (either once or twice a month) and deepen your connection and trust while exploring the theme. 
OUUC's **Faith in Action Ministry** covers a variety of justice issues such as homelessness, international peace, right relationship, criminal justice, and environmental sustainability.

Featured Opportunity #1: Audio/Visual Team




Fall Class Highlights
