Here is more information about the proposed budget. We believe this will support a vibrant congregation and faith and help us live our mission in the world. We know that this is a big ask, and one that the Board and Minister are confident this congregation can rise to.

## JUSTICE

- Expand the Faith in Action budget to include speaker fees for BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) leaders who journey with us in our anti-racism and anti-oppression work.
- Maintain the long-standing OUUC support of Interfaith Works, Olympia PRIDE, Quixote Village, JUUstice WA, and the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee (UUSC).

## HONOR CONGREGATION

• Moves OUUC further toward being an Honor Congregation with the Unitarian Universalist Association; it increases our UUA dues from \$6,000 to \$10,000. The full amount of our "fair share" contribution is \$26,691.

## STAFF FOR THE FUTURE

- **Community and Faith Development.** Allow Sara Lewis to broaden her responsibilities including Pathways to Engagement. We've also expanded the Religious Education Teacher to a RE Assistant with more responsibility and hours. Anissa Bentlemsani will grow in the RE Assistant role.
- **Media Specialist** position to help us refine our online offerings, build our social media presence, and develop vibrant and user-friendly ways to stay connected. We are delighted to have Jo Sahlin join us.
- **1% cost of living** increase for salaried staff and maintains health care and other benefits for staff working half-time or more. Our staff, in many ways, are busier than ever and constantly learning new ways to adapt to new technologies while taking on new duties previously unforeseen
- **OUUC Resource Ministry** is tended by Darlene Sarkela, administrator and Marie Arensmeyer, caretaker. Troy Fisher leads our music ministry, supporting transformative worship and offering ways for us to sing and connect, even now.
- An inclusive and integrated accounting system meant contracting with a professional bookkeeping service that knows the Realm system, has deep accounting expertise and knows OUUC. This transition is completed, and we are thriving with good accounting support that includes accurate, accessible, usable financial information.
