### **ANNUAL VISION OF MINISTRY**


The Board set a vision of ministry for the next church year (Sept-June) that is shown in the illustration below. The main areas of focus from the Board are:

# AND UU IDENTITY INTO YOUR BUSINESSY MEETING

It can be easy to get right down to business, to the Doing of things, but in a faith community like a congregation it's important to remember that we are here to shape and find our Why and How and Who With as much as our What, and that how we do anything is ultimately part of our mission.

Gathering to do the work of the congregation is a sacred task and an opportunity to be in deeper meaningful relationship with the others who also give their time for this work. So how can you bring more intention and take time for deeper meaning in the midst of business?

Does your team have a covenant with one another? How often do you review it or remind yourselves of that covenant?

Does your team have a mission or purpose statement or a statement of values? How often do you review that or remind yourself of your purpose?

Do you take some time for a chalice lighting or opening words or other centering practice before you begin your meeting?

Do you take time to check in and share what is happening in your lives so you can know each other better?

Do you hold retreats or other opportunities to just be together as a team and build community outside of business and work?

### **OPPORTUNITY OF THE WEEK PLANNED**
